Resident Procedures at Yamaguchi City

Yamaguchi residents must submit a Change of Residency Form

- Foreign nations who are legally residing in Japan for a mid to long-term period
 (over 3 months period, except for short term visitors) are required to register as residents in
 the same way as Japanese citizens.
- Those who have moved to Yamaguchi City must notify moving information to the Citizens Division of the Yamaguchi City Office within 14 days of finding a place to settle down.
- If you are relocated from another city in Japan, you must also submit a Change of Residency form as well as a Moving-out form issued by the municipal of the previous residency to the Yamaguchi City office within 14 days of relocation.

Required Documents

- Resident Card (this includes those in possession of a passport stating "Resident Card will be issued at a later date")
- Passport
- A document certifying the relationship between the householder and your family member *
 Only in the cases of being accompanied by your family or
 entering the existing household in Japan.

Procedures in case you are moving-out of Yamaguchi City

- When you are moving out of Yamaguchi city, please submit a "moving-out form" (tenshutsu todoke). You will be issued a "certification of moving-out" (tenshutsu shomeisho). You will need this certification when moving to another city in Japan.
- For those who are moving out of Japan and returning to a home country, it is required as a general rule to fill out a moving-out form even if a re-entry permit has been already issued by the Japanese government. If the moving-out form is not submitted, the responsibilities of the National Health Insurance and Pension Premiums tax payments will persist.

Lost or Stolen Resident Card

You must report immediately to the police station
 (Yamaguchi Police Bureau Tel: 924-0110) or and replacement for a new card should be processed at Immigration Office within 14 days of loss.
